CO-OPP'S Professional Development Assistance Program Updated

This spring the Awards and Scholarship Committee members were busy reviewing the Professional Development Assistance Program. Several changes were made to the program policies which go into effect July 1, 2020. The new program policies and application is posted on the CO-OPP website.

While the majority of changes made provide clarity to the policies a couple notable changes include:

- Expanding certification cost reimbursement for purchasing certifications other than UPPCC's certification. This could include certification from NIGP, ISM and others.
- Some of the individual funding amounts have increased to align with NIGP's class fees.

Depending on your activity level within CO-OPP you may be eligible for funds from \$100 to \$875. To qualify for funds:

- Have been a CO-OPP member for past 12 months
- Membership dues currently paid
- Attended 2 official meetings in the past 12 months
- Participated on 1 committeee any time in the past 12 months

Due to COVID19, and NIGP transforming the Annual Forum to a Virtual Event, your CO-OPP Board approved moving funds originally allocated for the President's attendance at Forum to the Professional Development Assistance Program's (PDA) budget. This move will support more members attending the NIGP Virtual Forum.

With moving funds to the PDA budget, the Mandatory Qualifications to receive PDA funds for registration to NIGP's Virtual Forum have been amended. This change will only apply to requests for funding to attend the 2020 NIGP Virtual Forum.

The following Mandatory Qualifications only apply to receive funding assistance for registration of the 2020 NIGP Virtual Forum are:

- Have been a member for 12 months prior to application date
- Attended 1 official chapter meeting during 12 months prior to application date

If you have been a member for 12 months and attended 1 official chapter meetings you can receive a minimum of \$100. If you are more active in the chapter you can receive up to \$875 dollars for your professional development.

Helpful Hints for Zoom Virtual Meetings

- If possible, join using a laptop, or computer instead of a phone connection. The system will run better.
- After joining a Zoom session, whether using a computer, mobile device, or phone, please place your device on mute and turn off the video. This will just display your name.
- Be mindful of background noise - when your microphone is not muted avoid making additional noise like shuffling papers.
- Limit distractions so you can make it easier to focus on meeting; turn off notifications, close or minimize running apps and mute smartphones.
- Avoid multi-tasking you will retain the discussion better if you refrain from replying to emails and texting messages.
- Post a Do Not Disturb sign outside your work area.
